- Development and Implementation of Goals and Key Performance Indicators for the Divisions within NCSLI

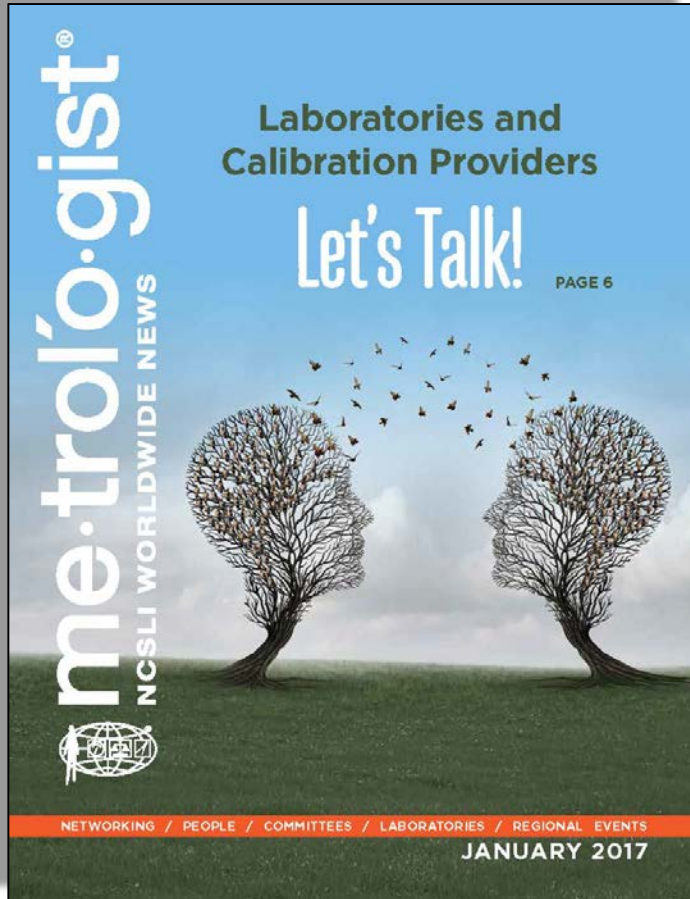


