

1. General information

Since the last SIM GA in the Autumn 2021, the most relevant ongoing developments in EURAMET have been:

- The launch of the **“European Partnership on Metrology”** on 31st March 2022 with the signature of the FPPA - Financial Framework Partnership Agreement. First projects start since September 2022.
- The organisation of the **EURAMET “February meetings”** (45th BoD, 20th Joint BoD / TC-C / EMN-C, 21st TC-Chairs Workshop and 5th EMN-Chairs Workshop) from 15th to 17th February 2022.
- The organisation of the **16th General Assembly**, that took place as a hybrid meeting from 30th May to 2nd June, 2022 in Vienna, Austria. It gathered 118 people involved in metrology activities: EURAMET Delegates, TC and EMN Chairs, BIPM, OIML, RMOs, WELMEC, NCSLi, as well as industrial and research stakeholders. During that event, **two additional EMNs were established on “Pollution Monitoring” and “Safe and Sustainable Food”**.
- The development of **European Metrology Networks (EMNs)**. The first 9 EMNs* are developing as planned, and in synergy with EURAMET 12 Technical Committees (TCs) they support the development of the EURAMET strategy for Metrology in Europe. Key tasks are to improve the interaction with key stakeholder communities and develop strategic (research) agendas.
* **namely:** *Climate and Ocean Observation, Energy Gases, Mathematics and Statistics, Quantum Technologies, Smart Electricity Grids, Traceability in Laboratory Medicine, Smart Specialisation in Northern Europe (Smart North), Radiation Protection and Advanced Manufacturing.*
- The adoption of the **BIPM e-Learning Platform** to promote EURAMET Capacity Building activities and assure knowledge transfer within our metrology community.
- The participation in the **BIPM-WMO Metrology for Climate Action Workshop** from 26th to 30th September 2022.
- The progress of specific actions to support the **digital transformation of metrology activities in EURAMET**: consultations and brainstorm activities to better define trends, needs and priority activities, development of an e-training platform, joint collaborations with institutes from other RMOs and Liaison Organisations, Project on Digital Calibration Certificates, etc.
- In collaboration with **WELMEC** (European Cooperation in Legal Metrology entity), EURAMET is actively participating in Legal metrology developments. They are currently working on a common European metrology webpage, unified positions on needs and expectations in regulatory aspects, and on digital transformation in metrology topics. Additionally, WELMEC has been very supportive in normative EMPIR research projects.



The most relevant **EURAMET matters and changes related to the CIPM MRA** were:

For 2 Designated Institutes, there was a change of name:

- in **Iceland, Housing and Construction Authority (HMS)** [*formerly Neytendastofa (NEST)*]. They also applied for the termination of their EURAMET membership, to be effective from 1st July 2022.
- in **Slovenia, Metrology Institute of the Republic of Slovenia/National Institute of Chemistry/Center for Validation Technologies and Analytics (MIRS/KI/D16)**. [*formerly Metrology Institute of the Republic of Slovenia/ /National Institute of Chemistry Slovenia/Laboratory for Environmental Sciences and Engineering (MIRS/KI/L05)*]. They also applied for the termination of their EURAMET membership, to be effective from 1st September 2022.

The scope of **E+E Elektronik GMBH (BEV/E+E)**, Austria, was extended by the additional designation in metrology in chemistry for carbon dioxide measurements in gas matrix.

Additionally:

- **LNEC-UHM** (Laboratório Nacional de Engenharia Civil – Unidade de Hidráulica Metrológica – Portugal) was accepted as **Associate (A-DI)** in EURAMET
- **KazStandard** (Kazakhstan Institute of Standardization and Metrology) was accepted as **Liaison Organisation** in EURAMET.
