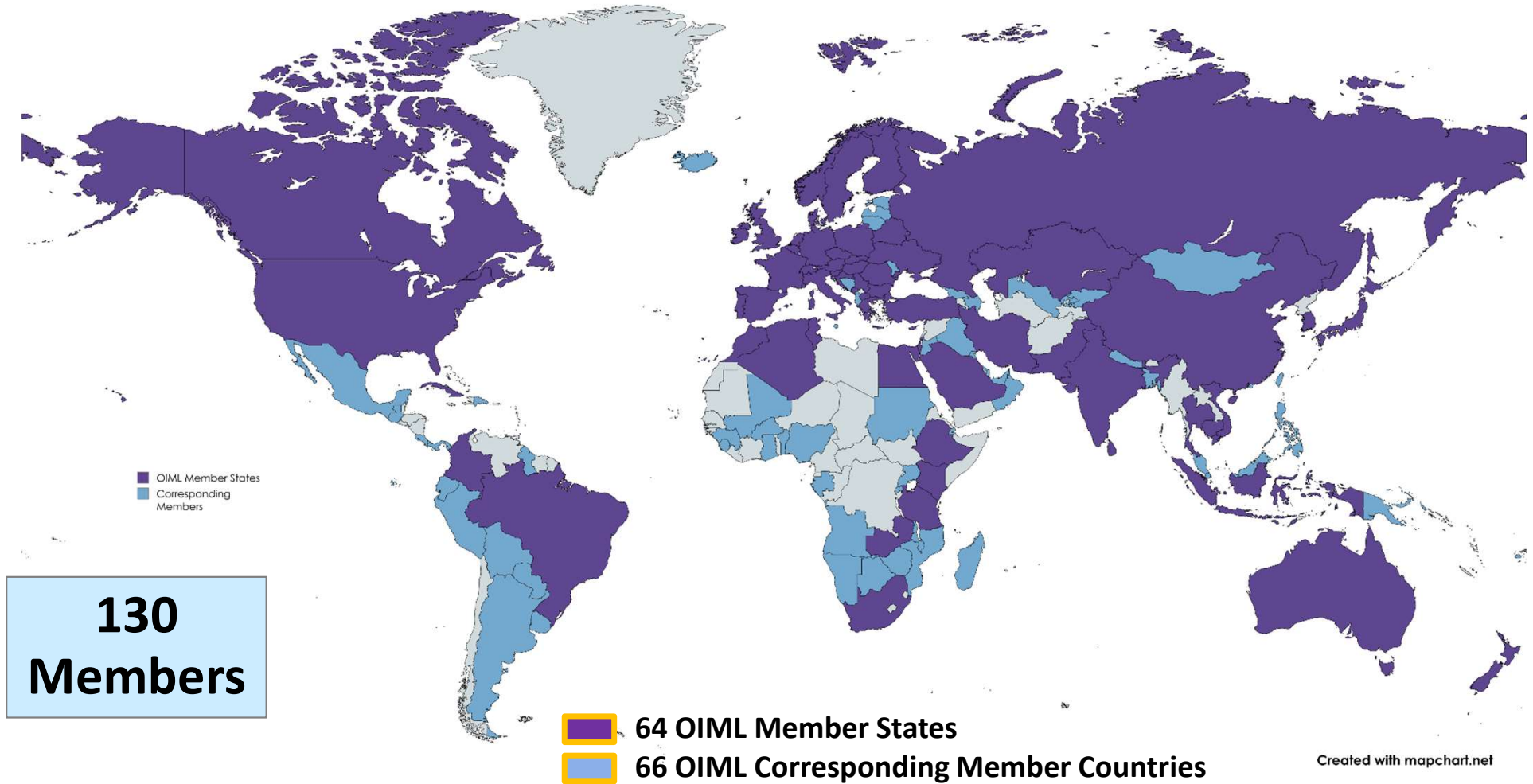

CIML Presidency

- President: Dr Bobjoseph Mathew (Switzerland)
- Ms Renée Hansson (Sweden) was elected as the CIML First Vice-President at the 59th CIML Meeting with immediate effect
- Second Vice-President: Mr Bill Loizides (Australia)
- Dr Charles Ehrlich (United States) completed his six-year term as CIML First Vice-President in October 2024 and will be retiring from NIST at the end of January 2025



17th Conference and 60th CIML Meeting (2025)

- The 17th International Conference and the 60th CIML Meeting will be held in Saudi Arabia in October 2024
- 2025 marks the 70th Anniversary of the OIML, founded in 1955



59th CIML Meeting (2024) Outcomes and Resolutions

Bureau International de Métrologie Légale (BIML)



OIML Technical work: Publications approved at the 59th CIML

- Revision of OIML R 49:2013 *Water meters for cold potable water and hot water*; the CIML also welcomed the close cooperation with the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) to ensure full harmonisation between OIML R 49 and the corresponding ISO standard ISO 4064
- Reconfirmation of OIML R 50:2014 *Continuous totalizing automatic weighing instruments (belt weighers)*
- Reconfirmation of OIML R 99:2008 *Instruments for measuring vehicle exhaust emissions*
- Reconfirmation of OIML R 106:2011 *Automatic rail-weighbridges*
- Reconfirmation of OIML R 107:2007 *Discontinuous totalizing automatic weighing instruments (totalizing hopper weighers)*
- Revision of B 20:2019 *Rules for the use of OIML logos*
- Amendment 2 to B 7:2013 *BIML Staff regulations*



OIML Certification System (OIML-CS)

- The OIML Certification System (OIML-CS) Management Committee (MC) Acting Chairperson, Mr Marc Schmidt (the Netherlands), reported on the activities of the OIML-CS, including the Ninth MC meeting held in New Delhi, India in March 2024
- Mr Schmidt welcomed the newest OIML Issuing Authority to join the OIML-CS, LNE-GMED UK Limited
- There is a desire for increased participation in the MC activities
- The CIML appointed Mr Schmidt as the MC Chairperson, and Ms Katharina Gierschke (Germany) as the MC Deputy Chairperson
- Both appointments are effective from 1 January 2025 for a period of three years



Countries and Economies with Emerging Metrology Systems (CEEMS)

- Mr Jaco Marneweck, Countries and Economies with Emerging Metrology Systems (CEEMS AG) Chairperson, gave an update on the activities of the CEEMS AG
- The CIML appointed Mr Ashutosh Agarwal (CIML Member for India) as CEEMS AG Vice-Chairperson for a three-year term with immediate effect



International cooperation: RLMO Round Table and International Liaisons

- The RLMO RT is a forum in which the six participating regional organisations can send representatives
- Objective: to share information on developments in their regions concerning legal metrology
- The focus is on training opportunities that may benefit all participants
- A summary of the RLMO RT Annual Meeting held on 30 September 2024 was presented by Dr Charles Ehrlich
- 7 Organisations in Liaison submitted written reports on their activities and 2 gave presentations (CECIP / ILAC)
- The BIML reported on its numerous liaison activities



OIML Digitalisation Task Group (OIML DTG)

- The OIML is part of the rapid global digitalisation transformation
- This affects all processes and services related to metrology, standardisation, accreditation, and conformity assessment
- A major step towards the digital transformation of metrology was the signature of the Joint Statement of Intent (JSI)
- The OIML DTG is a horizontal group consisting of 32 representatives from OIML Members and international and regional organisations
- The DTG Chair, Dr Sascha Eichstädt, reported on DTG activities
- The CIML approved the DTG Roadmap and the DTG Chair reported on the work of its Subcommittees “Smart OIML Documents” and “e-Learning”



World Metrology Day / UNESCO World Day

- 150th Anniversary of the BIPM
- 70th Anniversary of the OIML

- The theme for World Metrology Day 2024 is **Sustainability**
- The UNESCO General Conference designated 20 May as a UNESCO World Day of Metrology
- This will significantly increase global awareness of metrology's role in everyday life
- A launch event was held at the UNESCO HQ in Paris in May 2024
- 2025 will mark the 150th Anniversary of the BIPM
- 2025 is also the 70th Anniversary of the OIML:
to recognise this Anniversary,
a special logo has been designed
